

THE GAME COUNTER. MODEL: K1. MANUAL VERSION 2023.12

Before use. Insert the included battery into the counter by sliding the battery in from the open side of the battery holder with the positive side (+) against the holder as shown in picture.

Start counter. Press down button for 3 sec, damage value will be visible in display window. (Start value is 50.)

Set damage value. Click button for counting down 1 value at the time or hold down for fast value rundown. (Start value is 50.)

Turn off counter. Hold down button for 10 sec. (Counter will turn off automatically if idle for more than 1h.)

Display function. Display will dim down 50% after 5 sec after last button input and then turn off completely after 10 additional sec. (Last value will be stored in memory and will be displayed next time the button is pressed.)

Memory function. The counter will remember the last value until it is changed, value will be stored even if the counter has timed out and turned itself off.

Replacing the battery. Battery to be used is a *Lithium cell CR927 3V*. To replace the battery, use a plastic pointer to push the battery out of the battery holder as shown in picture. When installing the new battery slide the battery in from the open side of the battery holder with the positive side (+) against the holder as shown in picture.

Integration of counter in terrain/figure

- Make sure that the battery is accessible when built-in to make battery-replacement possible.
- Make sure that the bush-button is free moving for good functionality.
- It is possible to paint over the display with thin and bright colour and the LED will still shine through when activated.

Troubleshooting

- No display function when turned on; no battery installed in counter, check battery.
- No display function when turned on; discharged battery, check battery.
- No display function when turned on; battery installed upside down, check battery.




